### 2011 Tournament Rules

- Regular BNBC Tournament rules will govern except as noted below.
- Life jackets are mandatory and must be worn at all times the engine is running. Failure to wear a life jacket will cause disqualification.
- All contestants must be a member in good standing of the BNBC.
- Tournament hours will generally be from 5:30 PM to 09:00 PM. Any changes will be announced prior to take off and will generally depend on the length of daylight.
- To qualify for the year end classic you must physically participate in five (5) tournaments.
- Tournament entry fee is \$35.00/boat, plus \$5.00/boat for Big Bass.
- Breakdown of \$35.00 entry fee is as follows:

- A substitute team member may fish the Classic, if he is a member in good standing, and has fished in five (5) events.
